

- (b) to act on all matters referred to it by Synod;
- (c) to act on behalf of Synod between sessions thereof;
- (d) to report to each session of Synod;
- (e) to resolve that any component or activity within the Diocese be evaluated and should it so wish to recommend to the Bishop in what form and over what period such evaluation should be carried out, and, to receive and consider the evaluation reports and to then give directions as to any action to be taken; and
- (f) to do anything it is empowered to do by the various Acts of the Diocese.

Meetings

- 3** The Diocesan Council shall meet at least three times a year, except in a Synod year when it shall meet at least twice. It is empowered to appoint an Executive Committee and to make Standing Rules for the conduct of its business and that of the Archdeaconry Councils. Such Standing Rules must as soon as possible after the adoption of these Acts, be contained in a Diocesan Bylaw.
