

ACT SIX

Of Archdeacons

- 1** Archdeacons, who shall be appointed by the Bishop, shall hold office as such in terms of the provisions of Canon 15.2(a) and (b), save that no Archdeacon shall continue to hold office after he/she has reached the age of 65 years.
- 2** The jurisdiction proper to the office of Archdeacon also belongs to the Dean in the Cathedral Church. The Dean may also exercise jurisdiction as Archdeacon in such other area as may be specifically assigned to him/her by the Bishop within and adjacent to the Cathedral City.
- 3** Every Archdeacon shall perform such duties and shall exercise such powers as are prescribed by or vested in him/her by Canon 15, and on the instruction of the Bishop shall, either by himself/herself or through a Commissary, inspect and for this purpose remove from any Pastoral Charge within his/her Archdeaconry, the books of account and vouchers required to be kept in terms of the provisions of Act 15, Section 20. A report shall be made to the Bishop after each such inspection.
